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Safeguarding

Making sure our children are safe, and stay safe, both in school and outside is our primary responsibility and one we share as a community. Next week, we have requested an audit of safeguarding policies and procedures. On Tuesday, a team will visit the school and will be talking to pupils, parents and staff as well as looking at the site and our processes. In anticipation of this we would like to remind you:

- Scooters and Bikes should be pushed not ridden around the school site and parked carefully in the racks
- Children should be accompanied by a parent to the entrance to their class/the building
- Children should go into the school building by themselves
- If you wish to enter the school building at any time of the day, including after school, you must do so via the main reception where you can sign in
- At pick up parents should supervise their children as they leave the school site playground equipment should not be used at the end of the day
- If children have a mobile phone it MUST be left at the school office during the school day
