As you know this week we had a safeguarding review and we were pleased that all the systems and processes we have in place to keep the children safe are working well. However, we are always keen to look at how we can make our provision even better and we will be including more regular updates on safeguarding in our newsletters and putting additional information on our website to make sure that you as parents are kept fully informed of how we can work together to safeguard our children.

This week we would like to take the opportunity to ask you to remind your child that mobile phones must be kept in the office during the school day. Similarly, please make sure that your child is not wearing a watch that can take photographs, or record video or audio. These devices are not allowed in the school. This is in part because of the distraction they can cause and the potential upset should they be damaged. However, it is primarily because there are serious safeguarding implications associated with any videos, audio or photographs taken on these devices as these would not be taken with informed consent. As safeguarding our children remains our first priority please make sure your child does not bring these watches, or similar devices into school.
