#### MMR Vaccination

Primary-age children who have not received MMR vaccination are encouraged to book an appointment at the upcoming catch-up clinic

Measles is a highly infectious illness and can make your child seriously unwell. The free MMR vaccine is a safe and effective way of protecting against measles, as well as mumps and rubella.

Hounslow and Richmond Community Healthcare NHS Trust are running two catch-up clinics to provide MMR vaccination to primary-age children in Richmond and Kingston who have not yet received their MMR vaccinations. If your child has missed their first or second dose of the MMR vaccine, book an appointment at the upcoming clinic.


# Life to the Full Plus- Parents (Online Parent Portal)

# Traffic Issues (2<sup>nd</sup> Reminder)

We are all aware that St Mary Magdalen's is located in a tight cul-de-sac, in a residential road. It is of the utmost importance that our school enjoys a good relationship with its neighbours. However, this has come under strain recently due to some less than considerate behaviour by road users coming to the school. We are regularly receiving complaints from residents of Worple Street about parents or carers

dropping off or collecting children. Drivers reversing down the length of Worple Street, turning cars, engines being left running, and loud music from open car windows are the main sources of complaint. We would kindly ask parents to respect the local residents by parking at the railway end of the road and walking down the road to drop-off or collect their children. Please do not leave your engines running while you are waiting. If you do find that you need to reverse on Worple Street, please exercise the greatest of care. This is especially important with children crossing the road between parked cars at the beginning and end of the school day. Accidents are very possible when reversing and some parked cars have been damaged in recent days. Thank you for your consideration and helping to ensure the safety of our pupils and to protect the reputation of our school.
