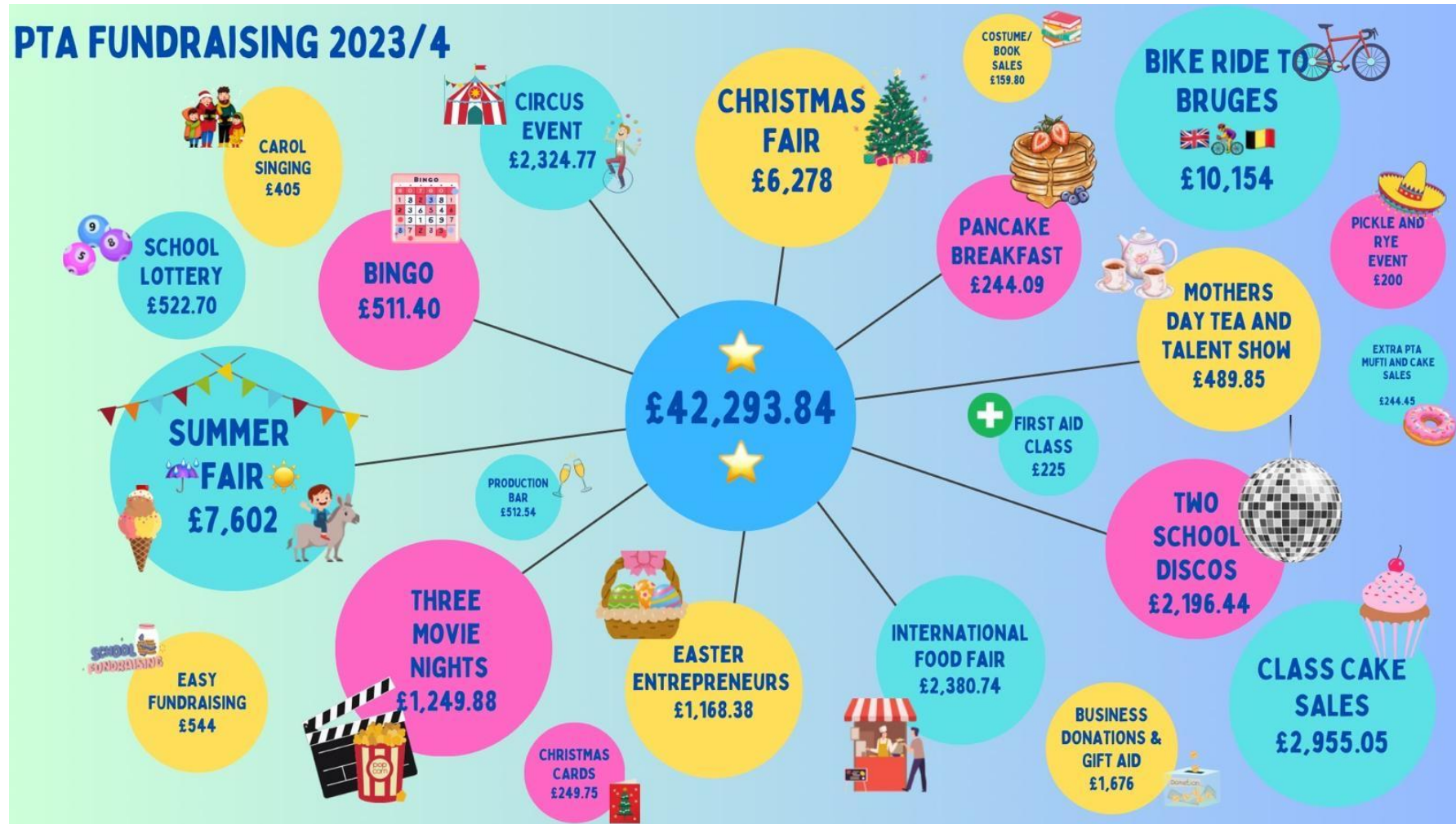


# ALTHOUGH WE ARE A SMALL SCHOOL, WE ARE MIGHTY!!
